

RIGHT TO REPORT

If you, or someone you know, are experiencing Inmate sexual abuse or Inmate sexual harassment, The Christian County Jail wants to know. We want you to report right away! Why?

- We want to keep YOU/THEM safe; it is our job! It is your right to be free from sexual abuse and sexual harassment.
- We want to conduct an investigation of the reported incident.
- We want to hold the perpetrator accountable for his/her actions.
- We want to provide YOU/THEM with relevant information and support services.

HOW TO REPORT

The Christian County Jail offers multiple ways to report sexual abuse and sexual harassment.

- Call 1-800-656-4673 for external reporting and if you wish to remain anonymous.
- Report to any staff, volunteer, contractor, or medical or mental health staff.
- Submit a grievance or a sick call slip (for inmates)
- Report to the PREA coordinator or PREA compliance manager.
- Tell a family member, friend, legal counsel, or anyone else outside the facility. They can report on your behalf by calling (270) 887-4152 or the Jailer.
- You also can submit a report on someone's behalf, or someone at the facility can report for you using the ways listed here.
